requirements of all parties involved. These include the recycling of leftover materials, developing new technologies, recruiting and retaining personnel and supporting lifelong training.

Delivering under adverse circumstances is a part of metrica’s path, the way to perfection as they say in their company slogan. The path begins with initial processes and goes through many phases with extensive work steps. Besides proven engineering processes ensure that metrica meets on-board classification requirements, co-operating with specialists and designers in research and development as well as testing of materials, to offer limitless possibilities to the client.

Following each step requires the expert know-how and outstanding skills of metrica’s artisans. To name one example, the stage of alternately priming and polishing these wooden surfaces is followed by up to 14 applications of a high-grade lacquer. These surfaces are examined, and those with even the tiniest of blemishes or indentation are eliminated. The final selected surfaces are then polished to a high shine.

Finishes of mother-of-pearl shell and gold leaf inlay add distinction to these surfaces, and these are further set apart with opulent touches such as fittings bordered with crystals and covers made from stingray leather.

The company understands the importance of selecting materials not only for their texture, pattern and colour, but also their weight, availability, certification, sustainability and cost. An efficient design process is executed by a team of metrica experts who ensure all classification requirements are met and co-operate with R&D teams as well as the testing of materials.

Great importance is placed on the smallest of details, and these are brought together in achieving impactful yacht interiors that are imbued with the owner’s personality. Across architectural millwork and these superyacht interiors, the company takes pride in emulating the precision and quality of Swiss horology, which uses the finest mechanisms to create objects of beauty.
